Water Authority Officers Elected

ROANOKE, VA – The Western Virginia Water Authority’s Board of Directors has elected new officers for the 2011 fiscal year. Serving as chair is City of Roanoke resident Marc S. Fink. Roanoke County resident R. Grayson “Gray” Goldsmith is the Authority vice-chair. Vinton resident Donald L. Davis and City of Roanoke resident John P. Bradshaw, Jr. were re-appointed to the Western Virginia Water Authority’s Board. Other members of the board include Roanoke County resident H. Odell "Fuzzy" Minnix and Shirley Holland, a resident of Franklin County. Serving as Treasurer is Authority Director of Finance and Administration Mr. Bruce Grant and serving as Secretary is Authority Executive Assistant Ms. Jean Thurman.

The Authority treats and delivers 23 million gallons of drinking water per day to 55,000 customer accounts (155,000 residents in the Roanoke Valley). The Authority treats 40 million gallons of wastewater a day from throughout the Valley at the Roanoke Regional Water Pollution Control Plant for more than 46,000 sanitary sewer customers. The Authority maintains 1,000 miles of water mains, 980 miles of sewer mains and 4,000 fire hydrants in the City of Roanoke and Roanoke County and Franklin County.
